Land of B. EDDS in Elm Grove Township, Section 32. This land is within a few miles of Circleville to the North East of the town. Circleville never made it as a town and is just farm land now (1994).

There is land owned by an EDDS, maybe T. EDDS in Section 28, just a little North East of B. EDDS land.

There is land owned by George MCCLEES within a mile West of Bartlett's land. Mary PRICE EDDS first marriage was to John MCCLEES so I would imagine that George is related to John.

The Weyrich Cemetery has a tombstone that reads "B. EDDS 1796-1871". This should be our Bartlett. It is in Section 2 of Sand Prairie Township. It is on the WEYRICH property less than 2 miles from Bartlett's land. Since Bartlett and Mary PRICE EDDS are not buried in the same cemetery I would guess that Bartlett's plot was purchased before they were married. There are KEMPERS buried in this cemetery so my guess is that Diana KEMPER EDDS, his first wife, is also buried there even though we can't find a stone.

The Woodrow Cemetery where Bartlett's wife, Mary PRICE EDDS, is buried is in section 36 of Cincinnati Township. This is less than two miles West of the Bartlett's land. There are PRICES that I believe to be her parents and brother buried very close to her.

The EADS and EDES are buried in the Mt. Hope Cemetery which is also in the Elk Grove Township, Section 13, just on the West edge of Tremont next to the A. AMES land. This is the family that I believe to be a brother or cousin of Bartlett's.

Thomas C. EADS, 1817 - 1895, and Rhoda S. EADS, 1817 - 1888, are buried in Miars Cemetery, Elk Grove Township, Section 27, just east of the land owned by T. EDDS.

William and Susanna EADS, (Not the son of Bartlett) are buried in Dillon Cemetery, Elk Grove Township, Section 34, just South of T. EDDS/EADS land, and just East of B. EDDS land.

There are surnames of most every one of the spouses of Bartlett's children, on the map, however the surname of RAINES/RANES is sorely lacking. They must have not owned any land.
